**WHO MAY APPLY:** Any senior graduating from GHS or homeschool who plans to further his/her education in agriculture or related field. Also eligible are graduating senior children of members in good standing of the Gunnison County Stockgrowers Association, regardless of their field of study in college.

If you are awarded the Gunnison County Stockgrowers Agriculture Scholarship, the

award can potentially extend over several years. The information provided here is to inform you of the award's sequencing, continuing eligibility, and reporting requirements that you must meet to continue receiving the scholarship.

#### AWARD SEQUENCING, ELIGIBILITY AND CONTINUING ELIGIBILITY:

- Maximum of \$250.00 per academic semester, and  
Maximum of \$500.00 per calendar year, and  
Maximum of \$2,000.00 per recipient, and
- If the award has not been fully satisfied, or terminated by reason of the failure of any of the conditions, the award terminates five (5) calendar years from the date of the recipient's graduation from Gunnison High School, and
- Recipient must maintain a 2.5 collegiate GPA in any semester enrolled, and
- Recipient must carry and complete at least 12 semester hours in any semester enrolled, and
- Unless a recipient's parent is a member in good standing of the Gunnison County Stockgrowers Association, the recipient must be enrolled in agriculture or ag related area as a major field of study.

Failure of any of the conditions listed above terminates the scholarship and the responsibility of the Gunnison County Stockgrowers Association, Inc., its officers, agents, members, or employees, to the recipient regardless of any amounts remaining under the \$2,000.00 maximum.

#### REPORTING

The recipient shall provide the Gunnison County Stockgrowers Association Board of Directors:

- Written official verification of enrollment at an accredited institution not later than 90 days after the commencement of the semester for which funds are sought;
- Name, address and office phone number of the student's on-campus advisor;
- Transcript showing the student is in good standing and received a GPA of 2.5 or better for the semester just completed, is maintaining a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better, the student is currently enrolled in 12 credit hours or more, and the student's major and/or minor field of study. This can be an unofficial transcript printed from your student account.
