To apply for the scholarship, interested students should submit the following:

- 1. Name, address, phone number, and GPA
- 2. Name of the institution and program you have been accepted at
- 3. List of foreign language classes completed (or a brief statement explaining foreign language abilities)
- 4. A brief narrative explaining why you should be considered for the scholarship
- 5. A brief narrative explaining why you chose the medical field
- 6. A brief narrative explaining your financial need for the scholarship
